DECA Advisor Professional Development Scholarship

Johnson and Wales University (JWU) has partnered with DECA for over 30 years. Now JWU will provide advisor professional development scholarships to support the practices of effective teaching and collaborative learning. This year, JWU will assist two DECA advisors in discovering new techniques to integrate DECA into the curriculum and successfully enhance students' learning experiences through participation at the DECA Chapter Advisor Summer Institute. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to qualifying DECA advisors.

The awardees must use their scholarship to attend one 2012 DECA Chapter Advisor Summer Institute. The JWU Advisor Scholarship will be applied to institute registration and lodging along with travel to the institute. Awardees will select from the following dates:

- June 20-23, 2012 in Providence, RI
- June 26-29, 2012 in Denver, CO
